

Parcevall Details

The theme for this year's Parcevall Hall event will be "Wassailing around Britain and Western Europe - songs and traditions". For our wassailing celebrations you can make a wassailing hat. (Look up "wassailing images" on the internet for inspiration, and our previous years' photos [here](#)); this is a hat which is decorated with greenery, ribbons, lights, flowers etc and is best prepared beforehand.

Other details for this event:

- Bring your Wassailing hat!
- If the weather is kind we shall be outside some of the time so -
- Bring warm clothes for inside and out - layers are best so that you can adjust
- **Do not arrive at the hall before 4 o'clock on Friday - Parcevall Hall staff will not let you in before then**
- You can arrive and park in the hall visitors car park for free before 4 o'clock if you want to go for a walk round the grounds
- You can drive up to the main building to unload/load, and then please park in the main hall visitors car park lower down
- The hall visitors car park is not the one next to the hall, nor the one at the bottom of the hill. It is at the top of the hill!
- Corkage of £5 is charged by PH for your own wines/spirits, and they have a selection of drinks to buy
- Bring indoor shoes - slippers or slip-ons are good
- Towels are provided, but bring toiletries
